PRE-OPERATIVE

Patients are admitted on the day of surgery. Skin prep: No shave is necessary. Clip excessive pubic hair Preoperative antibiotics: Rectal Metronidazole 500mg suppository given on admission TED Stockings to be worn perioperatively.

INTRA-OPERATIVE

Medication: Keflin 1g and Gentamicin 60-80mgm given IV on induction of anaesthesia. Calf compressors Sub cutaneous heparin 5000 sc bd to commence at end of procedure and continue until discharge.

POST-OPERATIVE PATIENT TO BE NURSED ON A WARD POST OPERATIVELY

Observation: Routine observations Check for blood loss

Elimination: Standard voiding Protocol

DISCHARGE

Patient may be discharged home if observations are satisfactory and voiding protocol criteria are met. Routine postoperative appointment at 4 weeks. Contact Dr Farnsworth or Robyn Tew if any concerns.
